## **New Business**

### **Approving Transfer of Grant**

With the passing of recipient, Michael Gray, his parents would like if the town would consider transferring the remaining portion of his CDBG Grant at the reduced term of four (4) years to their granddaughter and her husband. The four-year agreement would take in to consideration the fact that Michael had lived at his home for twelve months before his passing. As Marissa and Stephen DeForest do qualify under the income guidelines, they will have to sign a new loan agreement and a note of mortgage. The Board discussed this matter and have no problem with the transfer.

#### **Contribution to Wells Bridge FD for EMS Response Truck**

Last month, the Wells Bridge Fire District wrote a letter requesting help with funds to purchase a new EMS Response Truck. The quote was for \$46,995.00.

After discussion from the Board, they would like to contribute \$21,000 using the ARPA Funds at this time. Supervisor George DeNys will talk to Sidney to see if they would be willing to contribute also.

Deputy Supervisor, Ronald Reed made a motion to authorize \$21,000 to help fund an EMS Response Truck for the Wells Bridge Fire District with the request for George to contact the Town of Sidney to also contribute.

The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Jessica Grow and unanimously carried.

### **Privilege of the Floor**

**Garrett deBlieck** wished to thank the Town and County for the Resolution that was passed supporting our 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment rights.

**County Rep, Ed Frazier**, said that Otsego County has received the request for funds from the County's ARPA money from the Wells Bridge Water Association. The Association is seeking help to purchase supply's that will aide in and maintain safe drinking water within the Hamlet. He said the request in its second phase and hopefully we should hear something soon.
