Superintendent Rodney Renwick reported that roadside mowing has been completed, his team is working on ditch and shoulder work and work in preparation for road paving. They also continue to work on the salt shed. The town has also experienced storm damage from heavy rains, again, Rodney Renwick and his team are mitigating damage.

Superintendent Rodney Renwick filed NYS CHIPS reimbursement 284 agreement and payment is expected in mid-July, he also requested the NYS CHIPS report reflect the updated balance of \$427,053.22, Supervisor George DeNys made a motion to update and Allen Anderson seconded the motion.
